Iki by Reclaimed DesignWorks features black walnut lightly burnt in the Japanese style of shou sugi ban. Iki can be used for interior wall cladding, ceiling cladding and millwork in either select grade or character grade. Iki is available with a conversion varnish finish.

Reclaimed DesignWorks' charred offering features cypress, western red cedar, Accoya, Kebony, black walnut, red oak, white oak and reclaimed hemlock that is burnt in the Japanese tradition of shou sugi ban. Our award-winning charred products pay homage to the traditional Japanese technique of "shou-sugi-ban" aka "yakisugi" without being literal. Historically very specific in their definition, "shousugi-ban" and "yakisugi" have become common nomenclature for modern charred wood designs in general.
